### Two held in connection with gold-chain snatching case

Two habitual offenders with multiple cases registered against them have been arrested in connection with a gold-chain snatching incident that happened last month in Southwest Delhi. According to police, a senior citizen lady doctor was robbed of her gold chain in broad daylight in the Safdarjung Enclave area, when she was standing near the Green Field School. Police have recovered six gold chains, including the one robbed from the doctor and two motorcycles used in the crimes. The accused, Danish alias Chintu (32) and Ashish Taneja alias Bhatija (26), were arrested after the analysis of over 500 CCTV cameras across 700 km and eight districts spanning Delhi, Uttar Pradesh and Punjab, he said. "The robbery took place on July 25 when the complainant was standing beside her car near Green Field School in Safdarjung," DCP (Southwest) Amit Goel said.

### Voting to MCD postponed amid disruptions by AAP

The elections to the posts of chairpersons and vice-chairpersons of ad-hoc and statutory committees of the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) witnessed drama on Thursday, with the voting postponed following chaos and repeated disruptions by AAP councillors. The elections, scheduled on Thursday from 11 am to 4 pm, were marred by protests and altercations, officials said. The House had to be adjourned twice due to disruptions, with AAP councillors allegedly snatching ballot papers, attempting to break the ballot box, and clashing with security personnel. Delhi Mayor Sardar Raja Iqbal Singh condemned the incident and accused the AAP of dishonouring constitutional and legislative norms. "AAP neither respects the Constitution nor follows legislative procedures. Every time, they indulge in acts of lawlessness. When the BJP is conducting committee elections, they create disruptions to stall the process," he said. The Mayor congratulated the newly elected chairpersons and vice-chairpersons of other MCD ad-hoc committees, saying the BJP-led administration remains committed to improving services and ensuring good governance in Delhi. Meanwhile, Leader of Opposition (LoP) in MCD Ankush Narang accused the BJP of weakening Dalit representation by reducing the strength of the SC Welfare Committee from 35 members to 21. During the day, AAP councillors also staged a protest against what they termed an "anti-Dalit" move by the BJP, demanding the full restoration of the 35-member committee and a democratic election process that ensures the voice of the Dalit community is not suppressed. "The BJP is attacking Dalit rights by cutting down the committee's strength. We want proper elections in a constitutional manner," said Narang, adding that their protest was peaceful and in defence of social justice. While elections to other committees went ahead, the vote for the SC Welfare and Quota Implementation Committee stands deferred, with the next date yet to be announced, according to the statement.

# Domestic worker held for killing newborn

A 26-year-old domestic worker was arrested for allegedly strangling her newborn to death after giving birth in her employer's bathroom in Patel Nagar. According to a senior officer, the accused, who was working as a domestic helper since 2023, disposed the body in a trash bag. The woman conceived the child after she visited her village in November 2024 to attend a wedding, where she entered into a physical relationship with her boyfriend.

When she came to know about the pregnancy after coming to Delhi, she informed her boyfriend, who refused to support her, a senior police officer said, adding that she had been married once in 2019 and got divorced in 2021. "The case came to light on July 28 when a PCR call was received at the Patel Nagar Police Station reporting the discovery of a dead newborn in a white plastic bag in the parking area of a flat in West Patel Nagar," the officer said. Upon reaching the spot, the police team found the body of a male newborn stuffed inside the bag, following which the crime team was called to the scene. Subsequently, the body was taken to the mortuary for autopsy. During the preliminary inquiry, it was revealed that the domestic help working, a native of Raebareilly in Uttar Pradesh, had recently given birth, the officer said.

To conceal her pregnancy from her employers, the woman claimed she was experiencing a medical condition that caused abdominal swelling when they suggested she see a doctor. "On July 26, while the house owners were out at a party, she delivered the baby alone in the bathroom. She confessed to strangling the infant with a piece of cloth due to fear of social stigma, and then placed the body in a plastic bag, which she discarded in the trash area of the building," the officer added. Two days later, a sanitation worker discovered the body

while collecting garbage. The woman, who left the house earlier, was summoned, and the owner was informed, who then contacted the police. Following the recovery of the body, she was sent for medical examination, and inquest proceedings under Section 194 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNS) were initiated. The post-mortem was conducted on July 29 at the RML Hospital, which confirmed the death of the newborn by strangulation, officials said. On Thursday, a case was registered at the Patel Nagar Police Station under Sections

103(i) (murder) and 238(a) (offence of causing disappearance of evidence or giving false information to screen an offender) of the BNS, and further investigation was taken up. Before her arrest, she was held at the Sakhi One Stop Centre within the Lok Nayak Jai Prakash Narayan (LNJP) Hospital. Her statement will be recorded before a magistrate after obtaining legal counsel. The police also mentioned that her boyfriend, a resident of the same village in Raebareilly, will be summoned for questioning and may be arrested, depending on the outcome of the investigation.

### FIVE HELD FOR STEALING UNDERGROUND COPPER CABLES IN SOUTH DELHI

Five people have been arrested for stealing underground copper cables in South Delhi's CR Park and Sarita Vihar areas as contractors of a telecom company. Sameer, Amit, Arif, Shakeel and Amzad were arrested while attempting to excavate copper wire. Police recovered around 1,400 kg of stolen copper wire, along with a truck and a JCB machine used in the crime. They said that all five were found involved in more than a dozen similar cases of theft across the city. "The breakthrough came on the morning of July 28 when the police, during a routine patrol in the CR Park area, noticed unauthorised digging underway. While some of the suspects fled, Sameer and Amit were apprehended," Deputy Commissioner of Police (Crime) Aditya Gautam said. "During questioning, it emerged that the gang has been operating for nearly two years. They are based in Loni, Ghaziabad," the officer said.

### Delhi CM announces dedicated department for sports, youth affairs

Delhi Chief Minister Rekha Gupta on Thursday announced the establishment of a new dedicated department for sports and youth affairs aimed at nurturing young athletes. She made the announcement while interacting with children from the Delhi Olympic Association, various Government schools, and sports training centres at the Delhi Assembly. The CM also announced the establishment of sports coaching centres across Delhi to ensure that no athlete is left behind due to a lack of access or resources. "Every child in Delhi, regardless of their background, will now have the chance to receive professional training and pursue their sporting dreams," she added. The CM emphasised that the new department will focus exclusively on supporting and developing the potential of young athletes and the youth in the city. "Our athletes deserve more than applause — they deserve infrastructure, respect, and long-

term institutional support," she asserted. The CM recalled how, upon assuming office, she was moved by the dedication of Delhi's athletes, who, despite their perseverance, lacked adequate recognition and institutional support. "To correct this, we brought in the most progressive sports policy in the country," she said. Under this new policy, Olympic medal winners from Delhi will receive cash awards of ₹7 crore for gold, ₹5 crore for silver and ₹3 crore for bronze, making these the highest cash rewards offered by any Indian State. Additionally, athletes will now have the opportunity to secure Grade A, B, and C Government jobs, ensuring long-term career prospects. "These initiatives are not merely incentives," she noted. "They are foundational tools to empower our youth and help them chase their dreams with dignity and support. Our stadiums, long neglected, will also be renovated with state-of-the-art facilities, and the newly formed department will oversee all such developments," she added.

### Delhi Govt plans branding campaign to showcase culture, tourism in 2025-26

From radio jingles and airport hoardings to LED screens inside metro coaches and flight magazines, the Delhi Government is planning a branding campaign to showcase the Capital's cultural and tourism appeal in 2025-26. While Rs 5 crore has been allocated for branding, Rs 20 crore will be dedicated to enhancing tourism infrastructure across the city, according to an official. Alongside promotional campaigns, the plan includes participating in national and international

tourism marts, hosting festivals and upgrading key infrastructure across major tourist spots, said an official. To boost its presence across the country and abroad, the Delhi Tourism and Transportation Development Corporation (DTTDC) has lined up participation in several renowned tourism and trade events which include the India International Travel Mart (IITM), Travel and Tourism Fair (TTF), Outbound Travel Mart (OTM), South Asia Travel and Tourism Exchange (SATTE) and India International Trade Fair (IITF), he said. The tourism department

planned to organise popular festivals such as the Rakhi Mela, Dandiya Nights, Diwali Mela, Winter Carnival, North East Cultural Festival and New Year celebrations, according to the official. Other cultural attractions include the children's theatre festival, musical concerts, Delhi Film Festival and a unique Itra and Sugandhi Mela, he said. To enhance the tourist experience, key upgrades are planned at popular venues. Dilli Haat at INA will see redevelopment of its food court area, installation of 3D mapping, baggage scanners, CCTV cameras and other safety upgrades, according to the official.

### MCG aims to resolve Gurugram sewerage woes by April 2026

In a significant move towards improving urban infrastructure, the Municipal Corporation of Gurugram (MCG) has rolled out a comprehensive plan to permanently address the city's persistent sewerage issues. The target for completion has been set for April 30, 2026. The decision was taken during a review meeting of the Sewerage Monitoring

Cell held on Thursday and chaired by MCG Commissioner Pradeep Dahiya. Officials said the meeting evaluated sewerage conditions at around 40 key locations across the city. Commissioner Dahiya instructed officials to ensure timely execution of permanent solutions, while also emphasising the importance of providing temporary relief to residents in affected areas without any negligence. The MCG's plan places

special emphasis on villages located within the municipal limits, including Basei, Naharpur Rupa, Khandasa, Kadipur, Jharsa, Tighra, Ghata, Chakkarpur, Kanhai, Mohammadpur Jharsa, Narsinghpur, Begumpur Khatola and Bandhwari. Several urban residential colonies have also been identified for immediate intervention. These include Rajendra Park, Omanagar, Shanti Nagar, Hiranagar, Shivji Park, Laxmi Garden.
