Every month, 100 new Ayushman health centres: Govt

In a significant move to decentralise healthcare and ease the overwhelming patient load on major hospitals, the Delhi Government has announced an ambitious plan to inaugurate 100 Ayushman Arogya Mandirs every month. This initiative aims to bring essential medical services closer to the city's residents.

Following a high-level meeting at the Delhi Secretariat, Chief Minister Rekha Gupta directed health officials to fast-track the project. She emphasised that the goal is to provide faster and more efficient treatment for common ailments, thereby reducing the dependency on larger Government hospitals. The Chief Minister noted that the move would transform Delhi's healthcare landscape in the coming years. She stated that the Government would identify and utilise large Government

plots for these new health-care centres. While a 100-square-yard plot is deemed sufficient, the Chief Minister stressed the need for larger parcels of land. This would allow for the construction of bigger halls. These halls could be converted into emergency wards during a crisis. The larger plots would also accommodate parking facilities, a crucial necessity in many parts of the city. The Government is not just converting old primary health centres into Ayushman Arogya Mandirs. It is also building entirely new, modern facilities. To meet the aggressive monthly target, multiple Government departments are working in tandem. Procurement of medical equipment and non-medical supplies is being expedited. The recruitment of essential staff is also being fast-tracked. This includes doctors, nursing staff, pharmacists, and lab technicians. The chief minister also extended her gratitude to Prime Minister Narendra

Modi. She confirmed that the Delhi Government has already received ₹2,400 crore from the Central Government for this project. This funding, she said, ensures that the initiative will not face any financial constraints. The collabo-

ration between the state and the Centre is expected to streamline the implementation process.

The Ayushman Arogya Mandirs will offer a comprehensive range of 12 health-care categories. This includes

maternal and child health services, mental health support, and palliative care for the elderly. The centres will also be equipped for in-house laboratory testing. This will allow patients to get diagnostic tests done without

having to travel to a hospital. Currently, 67 such centres are operational across Delhi. The Government is confident that the new additions will significantly enhance health-care accessibility. These modern facilities are designed to provide dignified and sensitive care. The ultimate goal is to make these centres a symbol of public trust.

The initiative is seen as a strategic push to strengthen the primary healthcare network. By offering comprehensive services at the community level, the Government hopes to create a robust first line of defence against public health challenges. The focus is on preventive care and early treatment, which can help in avoiding more severe health issues. The new centres will play a key role in achieving this objective. The project is expected to create jobs for healthcare professionals and improve the overall health outcomes for the city's population.

DPCC to install 41 OLMS to track Yamuna water quality

The Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC) has floated a tender for the supply, installation and commissioning of 41 online monitoring stations (OLMS) to track water quality across the Yamuna and major drains in the city, up from 32 units planned earlier.

The project will also include five years of operation and maintenance, ensuring round-the-clock monitoring and transmission of data to the DPCC server.

According to the tender, six river locations — including stretches of the Yamuna and other rivers — will be equipped with systems to

measure flow, pH, biological oxygen demand (BOD), chemical oxygen demand (COD), total suspended solids (TSS), total nitrogen (TN), total phosphorus (TP), ammonium, dissolved oxygen, temperature and conductivity.

In addition, 35 drains discharging directly or indirectly into the Yamuna will be fitted with OLMS to track parameters such as flow, pH, BOD, COD, TSS, total organic carbon (TOC) and conductivity.

The decision follows a Delhi High Court order dated April 8, 2024, and was finalised at the 70th DPCC Board meeting and a review meeting chaired by the Director General of the National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMG) on July 24,

2025. Officials said the online stations will function in compliance with the latest guidelines and standard operating procedures issued by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB).

Earlier, the plan was to set up 32 online monitoring stations along the Yamuna river and various open drains to access real-time data on pollutants. The number has now been increased to 41. The purpose of the project is to track contaminants entering the heavily polluted water body and take timely action to mitigate them.

The DPCC is responsible for installing these water quality monitoring systems, which will measure a range of parameters including BOD, COD, TSS, TN and ammonia.

Delhi CM unveils Vedanta Half Marathon medal

Delhi Government to set up portal for investors to identify land parcels

To improve ease of doing business and streamline land allotment in the national capital, the Delhi Government will be developing a portal that

will serve as a centralised platform to help investors identify suitable land parcels, officials said.

The decision for developing this portal was taken at a recent review meeting held by the Ministry of Home Affairs on

compliance reduction and deregulation in Union Territories, they added.

The portal will be developed by the Delhi State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation (DSIIDC), with map-based data

support from the Geospatial Delhi Limited (GSDL), they added. The IT Division of DSIIDC has been assigned the responsibility of developing the platform.

"The Delhi Land Bank Portal will serve as a centralised,

online hub to help investors locate suitable land parcels for industrial and infrastructure development in Delhi," said an official. The divisional heads of the land administration divisions of DSIIDC namely Industrial Estate Management

(IEM) and Relocation have been directed to provide details of suitable vacant land parcels for making available on this portal by September 10, he added.

Once compiled, the information will be verified by DSIIDC's

Engineering Division to authenticate the actual coordinates of each parcel.

The verified data will then be forwarded to GSDL for integration with Delhi's geospatial map for display on the portal, the official explained.

Officials said the Delhi Land Bank Portal is expected to bring transparency and ease in the land identification process for potential investors, while also reducing bureaucratic delays and procedural complexities.
